RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

BS approved hard hats (PAS015) and Level 2 (or above) body protectors must be worn at all times when mounted. Medical armbands must be worn. All competitors are advised to have their own third party legal liability insurance as riding is a high risk sport.

If a competitor is eliminated for three refusals at any one fence they may continue, at the fence judges'/organiser's discretion, but must go on to the next fence making way for any riders coming up behind.

A horse fall will result in immediate elimination and the rider must leave the course on foot.

Bad language or excessive use of the whip will lead to disqualification.

The judge's decision is final.

No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may compete. No more than two rounds per horse/pony.

Course may be walked **Saturday 27th April from 2pm.**

Entries in person or over the phone will close on **Wednesday 24th April at 4pm.** Late entries and entries on the day will be taken subject to availability. There will be an additional £5 late entry fee. There will be no refunds or credits after Wednesday 24th April..

All dogs MUST be kept on leads at all times. Always clear up after your dog. Please take all your rubbish home.
