BS approved hard hats (PAS015) and Level 2 body protectors must always be worn when mounted. All competitors are advised to have their own third-party liability insurance as riding is a high-risk sport.

Only competitors may work in their horse/ponies prior to a class.

Bad language or excessive use of the whip will lead to disqualification.

No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may compete. No more than 2 rounds per horse/pony.

All dogs MUST always be kept on leads. Always clear up after your dog. Please take all your rubbish home.

The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event, alter classes, times or any other published information.

Winter League

You can join the Winter League at any time. You may enter as many classes as you wish, however each class will stand alone as far as points are concerned. You may compete on more than one pony/horse per class, but points will be awarded to the individual pony/horse rider.

Any pony/horse and rider that has been placed 1st to 3rd three times are not allowed to compete in class 1 or 2. Each height will have its own league table and prizes. Rosettes are awarded 1st to 6th.

Points are awarded on placings as follows:

1st = 6 points, 2nd = 5 points, 3rd = 4 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point

Please note: Our Winter League Show Jumping will run on our outdoor all-weather surface. The warm-up will be the indoor arena.

Class 1 will start at 10am

Class 2 won't start till 11 am, all other classes will follow on after.
